Garbage disposal rules



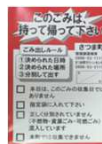
- Subject to leftover food, vegetable scraps, side dishes, etc.
- Vinyl Plastic etc. are not put in.
- Drain thoroughly.
- Chinese cabbage Large things such as radishes are should be cut into appropriate sizes



- Put in a town-designated burnable garbage bag, put it out to the designated garbage station.
- Remove filth and take out disposable diapers.
- Metal fittings, remove and put out.
- Put out garden grass without soil attached. Thick pruning waste is delivered directly (conditions below)
- Album photos should be put in burnable garbage. The bundled thing is put out in pieces.
- Water hose, cut within 1m and put in a town designated bag.
- Plastic that is hard to remove dirt should be put out in burnable garbage.

- ① Fixed date and time
By 8:30 on the specified date
 - ② Decided places
Designated place of local community (community association)
 - ③ Separate your garbage and put it out
Does not mix resources and non-fueled garbage
- ※ Garbage with a violation sticker on it will be take home by the person who put it out with responsibility.

<p>● If the handles of the paper bag are not made of paper, remove them. ● Cut it open and tie it crosswise with paper string or put it out in a paper bag. ※ Remove the contents, and remove any dirt from the burnable waste. ● Do not put it out on rainy days. ※ Put out thermal paper, paper with a smell (processed paper) in the garbage that can be burnable. Cardboard should not be placed in paper bags.</p>

Glass and ceramics



Vases, tea bowls, cups, mirrors, ceramics, oil bottles, ramme bottles, etc.

Metals



Wire, chain, pan, kettle, frying pan, can, milk can, nail, etc.

Spray cans



Gas cylinders, paints, insecticides, etc.
※Make a hole

Lighter/ Razor / Metal Lid



※Place in separate sachets for each type.

Bicycles, unicycles, baby carriages, car seats, umbrellas, telephones, fax machines, kotatsu, vacuum cleaners, fans, radios, pots, rice cookers, fluorescent tubes, hair dryers, toasters, printers, microwave ovens, stoves, clocks, gas ranges, etc.

●Put it out in the town designated bag (red). Put small things in sabi and put them in the same bag. The thing larger than the designated bag is put out as it is.
(60cm in height× 60cm or more in width)
● Be sure to remove oil from the fan heater stove.
● Put out the fluorescent tube without cracking.
● If there are batteries, etc., be sure to remove.
● Large hard plastic (costume case, baby bath, etc.)
※Waste from house demolition, renovation, etc. is industrial waste and cannot be disposed of at clean centers.

Garbage to be directly accessed to the clean center (follow the instructions of the workers in the field)



Cupboards, sinks, wardrobes, sofas, desks, study desks, tables, chairs, mirror stands, large sewing machines, large health appliances, beds, futons, blankets, carpets, rugs, pruning waste, etc.
Spring mattresses should be disassembled into cloth, cotton, and metal before disposal.

※Delivery caution: Totan, Eslon pipe, tatami mat, etc.

※ Tatami mats should be cut into three equal pieces, and carpets, carpets, blue sheets, and goze should be cut to within 1 meter.
※ Pruning waste, cut the branches to within 1m. If the branch is thicker than the wrist, it should be broken into small pieces.
※ (If the amount is large, contact the Clean Center in advance.)
※ Waste (tatami mats, waste materials, etc.) generated through demolition and renovation of houses will be industrial waste, so it cannot be disposed of at the Clean Center.

Documents related to personal information will be processed and issued by shredders, etc.

What cannot be taken up at the Clean Center

Industrial waste and waste that is difficult to dispose of



Building waste materials (tiles, cement, slate, fireproof boards), chemical and agricultural waste plastics such as agricultural machinery and agricultural chemicals, parts of cars and motorcycles (tires, batteries, etc.), fire extinguishers, gas cylinders, fireproof safes, solar electric water heaters, electric water heaters, etc.

※Ask an industrial waste disposal company to collect it.

PCs, mobile phones, tablets



※ Since it is collected by the manufacturer, if the manufacturer is not sure, contact the personal computer 3R center or mobile telephone company.

Four items of home appliances



LCD TVs, CRT TVs, air conditioners, outdoor units, washing machines, clothes dryers, refrigerators, freezers

※Ask the vendor who purchased the product or the retailer when you replace it to dispose of it properly. (Paid for)
